Pablo Picasso Art Museum

The first – and only – Picasso museum in Germany. Exhibitions showing works from a collection of over 800 Picasso lithographs alternate with works by the great Spaniard's contemporaries.

Cathedral Treasure Chamber

With its unique treasures of the goldsmith's and textile maker's art, this is one of the most important treasure chambers in Europe.

Münster City Museum

Over 1,200 years of history come to life in the Münster City Museum. Visit, too, the Hall of Peace in the historic Town Hall where, on 15 May 1648, a peace treaty was signed between the Dutch Republic and Spain at the end of the Thirty Years War, marking the birth of the Netherlands.

Westphalian State Museum of Art and Art History

Despite the reconstruction work currently going on, the museum holds collections from over 1,000 years of western art. Well worth seeing!

Museum of Lacquer Art

This amazing collection of lacquer art from east and south-east Asia, Europe and the Islamic world contains works from over two millennia.

Westphalian State Museum of Natural History + Planetarium

Culture, nature and astronomy – all at one address. The planetarium has the sharpest digital image resolution in the world.

Exhibition Hall of Contemporary Art

Just recently voted one of "the most courageous, innovative and convincing art halls of the year" by "Artforum International", the Exhibition Hall on the Dortmund-Ems canal presents contemporary visual arts on an area of over 1,000 m².

Mühlenhof Open-Air Museum

A must – especially for anyone who isn't Westphalian. The museum shows how our forefathers in – and especially around – Münster used to live and work.

Wolfgang Borchert Theatre

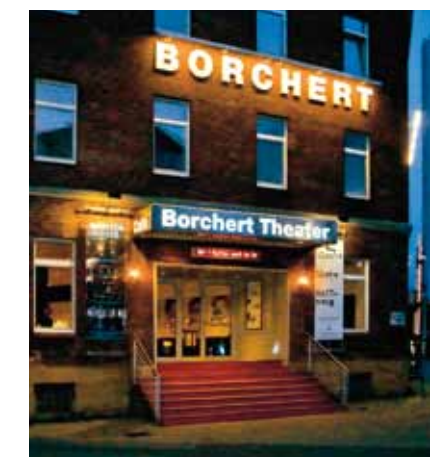
One of the oldest private theatres in Germany, this young ensemble delights audiences with its gripping or comical plays.

Feel the breath of history

History was written here – and its effects are still felt today. Münster and Osnabrück were the cities where the Peace of Westphalia was negotiated which ended the Thirty Years War in Europe in 1648 and placed international relations on a new footing. When you come to visit you can trace this piece of world history and at the same time discover two charming cities, each of which keeps the issue of peace alive in its own particular way. The weekend takes in a stimulating cultural trip to Münster and Osnabrück, which are only 50 kilometres apart. By the way: you can start your trip in Münster or in Osnabrück, just as you please.

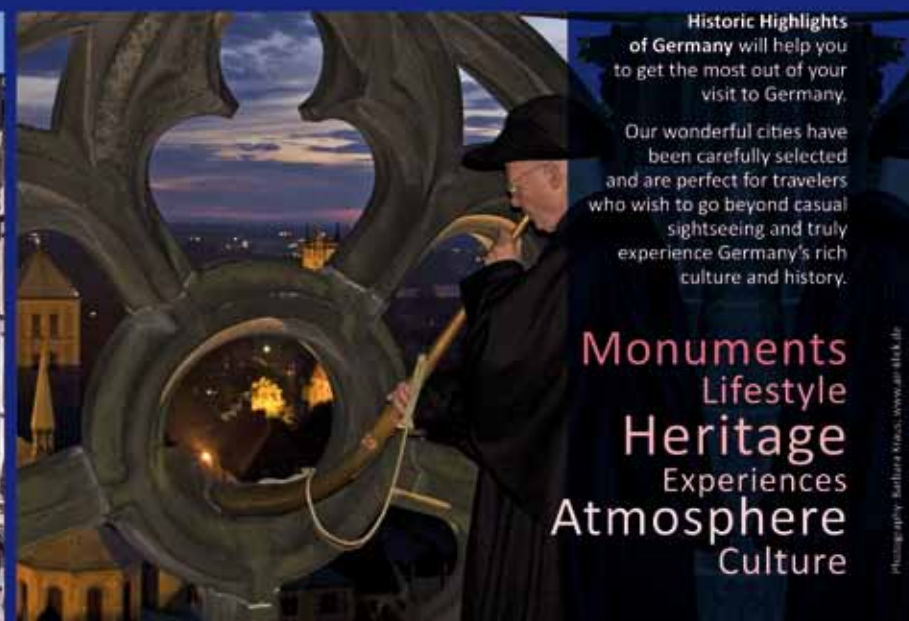

Sparkassen Münsterland GIRO Cycling Tournament 2011

Do you love cycling?

Then you should make a note for October. That's when cycling's top riders meet in Münster once again for the Sparkassen Münsterland GIRO tournament. This top-flight meeting forms a finale to the season and lives up to Münster's reputation as the cycling capital of Germany. 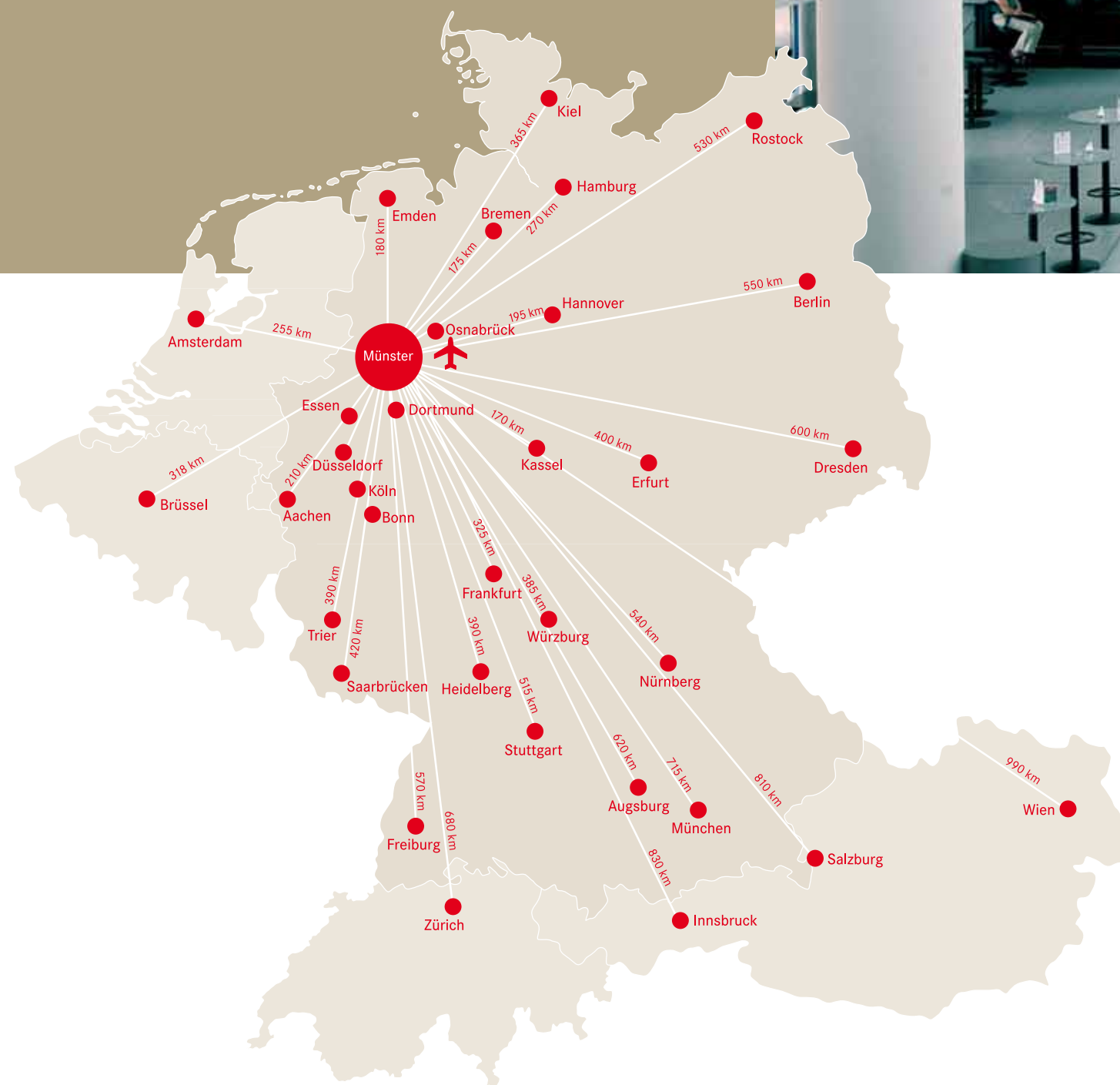
